## **WOW!** and Ghatronic

The discussions with Sabrina and Bjoern from WOW! were very successful. They advocated for Ghatronic and offered to donate six (6) snoopers to the trainers and that the program or software will be installed on the laptops of the trainers for free, together with free updates.

Ghatronic will only have to pay for the freight and customs in Ghana. We will get 10 Snooper in a first shipment, in 2 packages, 6 Snoopers for our new trainers.

Technical Information: The WOW! diagnostic system consists of a snooper that is plugged into the diagnostic socket in the car and software that can be installed on a laptop. The snooper and the laptop are connected via Bluetooth. The information the snooper picks up can be processed by the diagnostic program on the laptop.

## **GIZ** and Ghatronic

(The Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) is an organization of the Federal Republic of Germany that works internationally on behalf of various ministries of Germany).

The first negotiations were promising but the down-to-earth approach from Ghatronic is not the line of action of the big institution GIZ. We are still open for the kind of cooperation, both parties must be respected.

Currently we are in discussions about the possibilities for GIZ and Ghatronic in the Suame Project: (Suame Magazine is an industrial area with many metal engineering and vehicle repair workshops in Ghana, employing an estimated 200,000 people):

- KNUST/TCC are getting a grant from GIZ. They are employing the independent trainers of Ghatronic, they train the mechanics. (KNUST = Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology; TCC = Technology Competence Centre of KNUST)
- The trainers will hold the seminars with the teaching resources from Ghatronic (Power Points, Snooper, Knowledge...). The trainers are independent, they will negotiate and agree with KNUST about syllabus, time of seminars, time plan of the education and payment.
