



The trainers employed at the TCC training centre at Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology in Kumasi are still working there and would like to conduct more training courses and repairs. Unfortunately, the planned advertising measures have not yet been implemented. Training courses at the Technical University and in Evans' workshop have also continued.

The Ghatronic Foundation received a request from the Tamale Branch of the Ghana National Association of Garages (GNAG) asking whether the Ghatronic Foundation could hold seminars for local car mechanics in the Tamale Metropolis.

Seminars are to be held in Tamale for around 200 car mechanics, master mechanics and their apprentices. The two main trainers of the foundation, Evans and Chris, agreed to conduct the seminars and began planning, as this very interesting additional project must not interfere too much with the work and training in Kumasi. Furthermore, Tamale is about 400 km away from Kumasi. In addition to Evans and Chris, Richard, the junior trainer, will accompany the seminar to gain further experience in organising seminars.

The board and Wolfgang worked out the details of the plan, and a proposal was prepared.

**The current plan is as follows:**

**PHASE 1:**

Ghatronic will initially hold the following pre-prepared seminars in Tamale for 30 to 50 participants:

Phase 1a: one week in February 2026 – Basic Course

Phase 1b: one week in March 2026 – Diagnosis troubleshooting

Phase 1c: one week in April 2026 – Engine Management

as well as a brief summary of - Overview of hybrid vehicles, braking systems, sensors

**PHASE 2:**

Beginning in May 2026, the five best seminar participants will have the opportunity to undergo further training for around one month at Evans' workshop and at the TTC Centre in Suame (Kumasi). This will enable them to continue the seminars in Tamale on their own afterwards. It will also ensure that the know-how is shared and that the Ghatronic 'train the trainer' concept is realised.

**PHASE 3:**

The training courses will be continued independently by GNAG Tamale Branch for the remaining 150 mechanics.

The financial planning can be found in the special document "Tamale Seminar Project". Currently, it appears that Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology will participate in the project.

On December 12, 2025, we were allowed to use the lobby of the hotel in Kumasi, which now has excellent Wi-Fi. This meant that Björn Schleifer from WOW! Würth Online World GmbH was able to give the training on the Coolius AC service unit online again this time. The updates for the diagnostic software were also activated during this session. Since Windows 11 is now required for this, we first had to buy a used laptop; financially, it was not possible to buy more than one at the end of December. As always when working with Björn and WOW, everything worked extremely well! Thank you very much again!  
A used laptop with Windows 11 now costs 5,500 Ghana cedis, which is about 450 Euro depending on the exchange rate. We will work to achieve this in 2026; we still need 4 laptops.



From the end of November to the end of December, Wolfgang was in Accra and Kumasi to hand over some necessary organizational matters to the new board and complete the registration of the association. District registration must be renewed every year, and the national registration, which we started more than a year ago, was delayed. Other officials are now responsible for processing the applications, as the government changed in January 2025. Our consultant is confident that the national registration will soon be completed, which will also eliminate the need for the annual renewal of the district registration.
